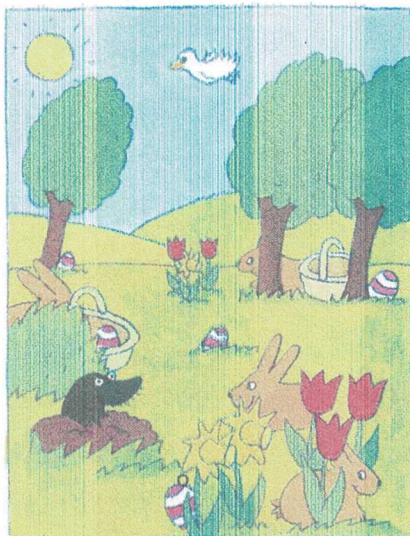
# Blacky the mole
